

Terms and Conditions 2019

THE PROMOTER

The promoter is: Softcat plc of Solar House, Fieldhouse Lane, Marlow, Buckinghamshire, United Kingdom SL7 1LW ("Promoter").

THE COMPETITION

The title of the competition is 2019 Podcast Cassette Competition

Operation of competition: Subscribe to the Explain IT podcast and be entered into a draw to win one of two pairs of headphones. Registration to play must be no later than 11pm on 28th February 2019. Promoter will choose two entries at random to win one of the pairs of headphones.

The competition will run from 10am on 18 January 2019 (the "Opening Date") 11pm on 28th February 2019 (the "Closing Date") inclusive. All registrations must be received by no later than 11pm on the Closing Date. All competition entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified. To enter the competition, subscribe to the podcast and complete the form at Softcat.com/explainit-casette on Softcat's website. No purchase necessary.
